

Notice to Principals is Notice to Agents; Notice to Agents is Notice to Principals

This serves as **Second Notice** to Governor Mike DeWine and the STATE of OHIO and the State of Ohio. This also serves as Second Notice to all whom Governor DeWine had obligation and duty to inform. Additionally, let it be known to all to whom these Presents come: This is your lawful notice that The Ohio Assembly, unincorporated, is in session and the Ohio Trust has returned to the oversight and lawful possession of the naked Priority Credit Donors. The original notice was sent on September 21, 2020. It has cured with no response or rebuttal and, therefore, has now become a tacit contract with the People of Ohio, The Ohio Assembly, Land and Soil Jurisdiction, hereinafter referred to as "Ohioans". Our original Notice required the following actions:

- 1. Ohioans are free to travel in unregistered private-use cars and trucks and are not subject to licensing of their private use of public roads, their marriages, or their unregulated business activities; as a courtesy, Ohioans will be issued State Credentials in lieu of Driver Licenses and their declaration of political status will be recorded and available in public record; Thompson v.Smith, 154 § 579, 11 American Jurisprudence Constitutional Law, § 329, page 1135; Teche Lines, Inc. v. - 2. We require that Ohioans have access to directly purchase private automobiles and receive the Manufacturer's Certificate of Origin (MCO) without interference or interception by any federal agency, department or State of State franchise; Molway v. City of Chicago, 88 N.E. 485, 486, 239 Ill. 486; Smiley v. East St. Louis Ry. Co., 100 N.E. 157, 158
- 3. We require that Ohioans' natural <u>exemption from registration of their private automobiles</u> be recognized and published and that Ohioans who are not using the public roads for the benefit of commercial enterprises be issued "Regulation Z tags" to replace the registration tags on their cars and trucks and to serve as notice of their private use status. This also precludes their Manufacturer's Certificate of Origin (MCO) being returned to them

- 4. We require that all federal, state of state, and incorporated county personnel and organizations operating within the physical boundaries of Ohio be properly educated and advised of the following facts:
 - Ohio State Nationals and Ohio State Citizens, herein referenced throughout as "Ohioans", exist apart from all federal citizenship obligations and represent, from the federal and federated state-of-state perspective, a non-domestic population which is naturally exempt from federal code and regulation, except insomuch as some rare individuals may actually be engaged in the interstate manufacture, sale, or transport of alcohol, tobacco or firearms as properly defined. 1818: U.S. v. Bevans, 16 U.S.336; Chisholm v Georgia, 2 Dall. 440, at pg 471; Gardina v. Board of Registers 48 So. 788, 169 Ala. 155 (1909)
 - Ohioans on the Land and Soil Jurisdiction are sovereign. We are not "sovereign 4.2. citizens" and can never be sovereign and a citizen at the same time by the very lawful and legal definitions of "citizen". It is ignorant, deliberate slander and misidentification for unlawful purposes. Cherokee Nation v. Georgia, 30 U.S. (5 Dredd Scott v Sandford, 60 US 393, at pg 404Pet.) 1 (1831); People v Herkimer, 4 Cowen (NY) 345, 348 (1825); Lansing v Smith, (1829) 4 Wendell 9,20 (NY; Ohio L. Ins. & T. Co. v. Debolt, 16 How. 416, 14 L.Ed. 99; Yick Wo v Hopkins, 118 US 356, at pg 370;
- 5. Ohioans are not to be detained or arrested for code, regulatory or statutory infractions; Article IV, Section 2 Clause 1; Penhallow v. Doane's Administraters 3 U.S. 54; 1 L.Ed. 57; 3 Dall. 54, (1795); Windle v. Flinn, 196 Or. 654, 251 P.2d 136, 146; Atkins v. Lanning. D.C.Okl., 415 F. Supp. 186, 188.
- 6. Ohioans may be in possession of guns and other weapons, either concealed or open carried; 2nd Amendment Bill or Rights Constitution of the United States; District of Columbia v. Heller, 478 F.3d 370
- 7. Ohioans are owed all Constitutional guarantees and exemptions and claim these guarantees and exemptions;
- 8. Now that the Ohio Assembly is back in Session, you will be aware of Ohioans as a separate population and will be dealing with our Assembly Sheriffs and Court System; the Ohio Court System is being restored under the provisions of Ex Parte Milligan, 71 US 2; our Ohio Court System serves Ohioans populating the land and soil jurisdiction of Ohio, while the State of Ohio Court System will continue to serve Territorial and Municipal residents of our State:
- 9. Any incorporated entity or foreign Person/PERSON operating unlawfully or for unlawful purposes in Ohio is subject to international prosecution and revocation of their charter and additional fines, fees, and punitive measures may apply;
- 10. All personnel attached to the State of Ohio, the STATE OF OHIO, their agents, receivers, seconds, successors, and assigns, parent corporations and principals are hereby required to take affirmative action and prudent Notice in compliance with this instruction from The Ohio Assembly.

Governor DeWine has failed to properly inform and take affirmative action upon the Notice issued September 21st, 2020. Ohioans have suffered trespass of their Constitutionally guaranteed rights as a result of his willful failure.


