This is official NOTICE from The Ohio State American Common Law Living Court to all State of Ohio Courts that The Ohio American Common Law Living Court now has capacity and standing to adjudicate the affairs of living men and women on the Land and Soil jurisdiction known as American State Nationals and American State Citizens.

An Ordinance for the Government of the Territory of The United States North-West of the River Ohio (1787), still in effect, and in affirmation of the rights of living men and women to be governed by Common Law, states:

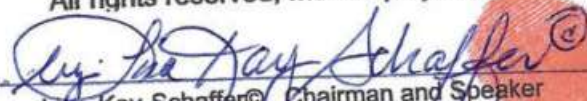
"The inhabitants of the said territory shall always be entitled to the benefits of the writ of habeas corpus, and of the trial by jury; of a proportionate representation of the people in the legislature; and official proceedings according to the course of the common law. All persons shall be bailable, unless for capital offenses, where the proof shall be evident or the presumption great. All fines shall be moderate; and no cruel or unusual punishments shall be inflicted. No man shall be deprived of his liberty or property, but by the judgment of his peers or the law of the land; and, should the public exigencies make it necessary, for the common preservation, to take any person's property, or to demand his particular services, full compensation shall be made for the same. And, in the just preservation of rights and property, it is understood and declared, that no law ought ever to be made, or have force in the said territory, that shall, in any manner whatever, interfere with or affect private contracts or engagements, bona fide, and without fraud, previously formed"

This is an Invocation of the Supreme Court ruling known as EX PARTE MILLIGAN; Ex parte Milligan, 71 U.S. 2 (1866), Americans are not subject to the authorities of Military War and are owed the Law of Peace, Law of Peace DOA PAM 27-161-11956;

American State Nationals will in the future be brought before our American Common Law Living Court on the Jurisdiction of the Land & Soil; Your cooperation and attention is expected and appreciated;

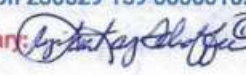

The Ohio Assembly currently in session, brought before it's American State Citizens, the proposed International Peace Proclamation, for a Roll Call Vote. After thorough review, Ohio American State Citizens vote Yea unanimously in favor of the International Peace Treaty.

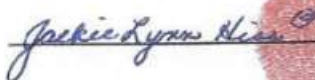
